People know that at its core, Christianity has something good to offer the human race. At the same time, many have a sense that they are alone in being a "thinking" Christian and that "salvaging" Christianity is a hopeless task. What is needed is a safe environment where people have permission to ask the questions they've always wanted to ask but have been afraid to voice for fear of being thought a heretic. *Living the Questions (LtQ)* is a 21-week DVD small group study exploring beyond the traditions and rote theologies in which so many people and local churches seem to be stuck.
