Epiphany Outreach Campaign-Welcome Deacon Reeve

Deacon Susan Reeve was ordained in 1999. She serves as the deacon at St. Brigid's Church in Rio Vista, a parochial mission of Grace Church, Benicia. **As the first guest speaker in our Epiphany Outreach Campaign Susan will speak to us about her work with Kairos Outside.** She is a chaplain and an advisory council member and has led retreats and Kairos support teams. Kairos Outside is an ecumenical organization that addresses the spiritual needs of the families of men and women, who are incarcerated, or have been incarcerated, in state or federal correctional facilities. In her secular work Susan is the Supervising Librarian at the Solano County Library in Rio Vista.
