Forgiveness: Three Lectures presented by Dean Brian Baker

Radical Forgiveness: God's Call to Unconditional Love by Brian Zahnd

This class will attend Dean Brian Baker's lectures on **Forgiveness** Thursday evenings, February 13, March 20 and April 10th.

Recover the true beauty of Christianity as found in forgiveness. If Christianity is to be a compelling and relevant voice in the twenty-first century, it needs a return to its roots. Beginning with the horror of the Holocaust, **Radical Forgiveness** explores what forgiveness means—and how far it should go—in the real world of rape, child abuse, genocide and other atrocities. With honesty and compassion, Zahnd tackles questions such as: Should we always forgive? Is forgiveness always even possible? Does forgiveness enable evil? Does it sacrifice justice? Are there ANY limits?
