Radical Forgiveness: God's Call to Unconditional Love by Brian Zahnd

Presented by Canon Lynell Walker and co-leader Book available for the purchase in the Trinity Bookshop Meetings on February 20, 27, March 6, 13, 27, April 3 in the Assembly Area. This class will attend Dean Brian Baker's lectures on **Forgiveness** Thursday evenings, February 13, March 20 and April 10th.

Recover the true beauty of Christianity as found in forgiveness. If Christianity is to be a compelling and relevant voice in the twenty-first century, it needs a return to its roots. Beginning with the horror of the Holocaust, **Radical Forgiveness** explores what forgiveness means—and how far it should go—in the real world of rape, child abuse, genocide and other atrocities. With honesty and compassion, Zahnd tackles questions such as: Should we always forgive? Is forgiveness always even possible? Does forgiveness enable evil? Does it sacrifice justice? Are there ANY limits?

Getting Started with the New Bible and Book of Common Prayer Challenge
