### Growing in Faith:

#### Introduction to the Old Testament — Room A

This course starts today and continues through August 16. (No, you don't need to attend all classes.) Bring your Bible. If you forgot it or (don't have one [gasp!], bring it next week. NO KNOWLEDGE OF THE BIBLE REQUIRED; just interest and curiosity. We start with the basics (What is the Bible? What does "OT" stand for? **June 21-27**

Our Family Promise families return to the Cathedral on Sunday, June 21, and will again be staying in the Great Hall for a week. We need folks to provide a dinner each evening; evening hosts who can serve, clean up, and make sure the families' needs are provided for; and overnight hosts who ensure their security and comfort while they spend the night in the Great Hall. If you like, you can drop off an entree for dinner before 5:30 p.m. and we will prepare it for you. (Please make sure you leave instructions if you go this route! Some of us are experienced cooks, but many are not and need some clues.) Family Promise is a national organization which transitions homeless families into stable homes and employment. The Sacramento center has been the most successful in the network, with 30 families placed into housing and jobs last year.
