Rally and Service of Thanksgiving

Date/Time to be Announced

The United States Supreme Court will soon announce a landmark ruling regarding marriage equality and most specifically the rights of lesbian and gay couples to marry in all fifty states. This ruling will be announced during the month of June.

Trinity Cathedral is working with a coalition of faith community members to actively participate in two events:

- On the day the ruling is announced there will be a rally on the steps of the Capitol building at 6:00 pm. Please join us to ensure that the Sacramento faith community is represented!
- On the Sunday following the ruling a multi-faith Service of Thanksgiving will be held at 3:00 pm. Regardless of the decision, the tone of the service will be one of thanksgiving. We are thankful for God's wonderfully diverse creation. We are thankful for God's presence in our lives. We are thankful to be blessed with the knowledge that the Holy Spirit will continue moving to bring justice and peace to our world. The service will be held at Congregation B'nai Israel on Riverside Blvd. unless the ruling is announced the last week of June making the service day fall on Sunday, June 28th. In that case, the service will be held at Pioneer Congregational United Church of Christ on 27th and L Streets.

I hope that you will take these opportunities to join with others to show God's love as we stand together in thanksgiving and solidarity with the LGBT community and all people of conscience.
