July 11: Karl Greene presents **Oscar Romero:** Archbishop of El Salvador who brought "liberation theology" to the attention of all Christians. He was assassinated on March 24, 1980 while celebrating Eucharist.

July 18: Morey Lloyd presents **Queen Calafia:** A saint in Her Own Rite — Mother of both Northern & Southern California.

July 25: Susan VanDyke presents **Andrew Young** Civil Rights Leader, Pastor, Ambassador, Mayor, Son, Father, God-Father, American Citizen
