Annual Transgender Day of Remembrance Candlelight Vigil

6:30 pm on Saturday, November 18 at Trinity Cathedral

The International Transgender Day of Remembrance memorializes those killed due to their actual or perceived gender identity and expression. The first memorial was a candlelight vigil in November 1999 to honor Rita Hester, murdered in 1998. Since then, annual memorials have been observed around the world around November 20.

Trinity Episcopal Cathedral, the Sutter Gender Identity Support Group, the Gender Health Center, and PFLAG Sacramento are pleased to co-sponsor the Annual Candlelight Vigil in observance of the International Transgender Day of Remembrance on November 18.
